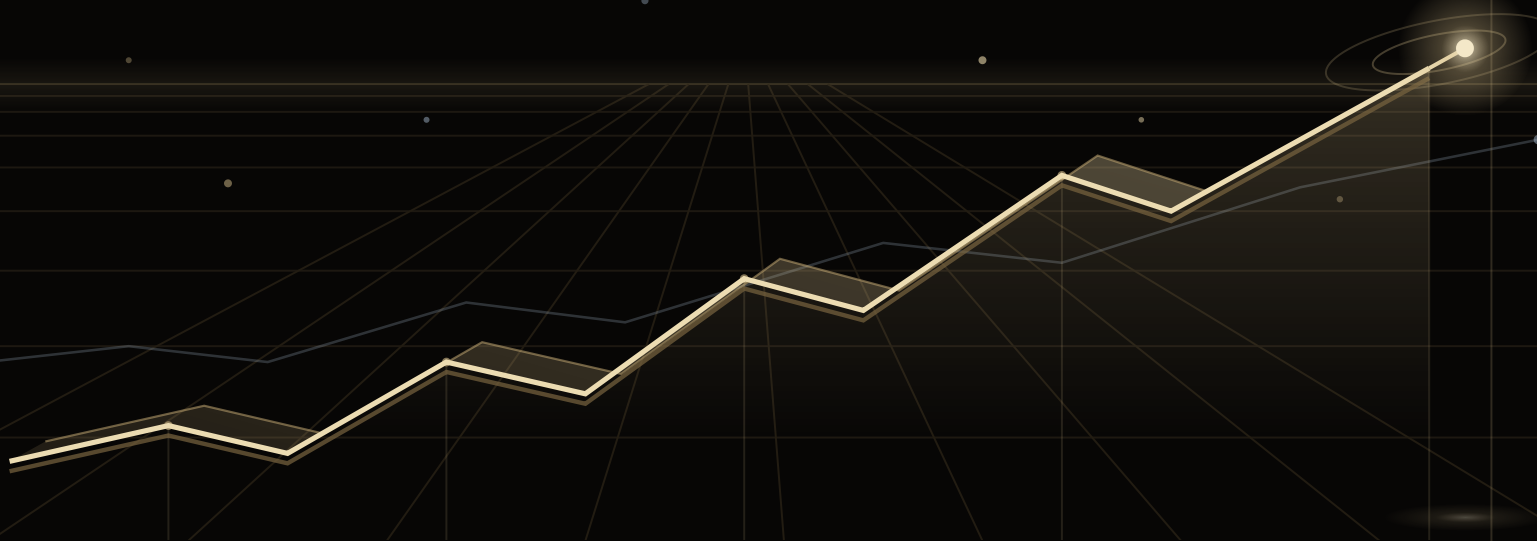

What you need *first*

✓ A TradingView account

The **free plan is enough** — the indicator works on any plan. New account: tradingview.com → Sign up.

✓ Your TradingView username

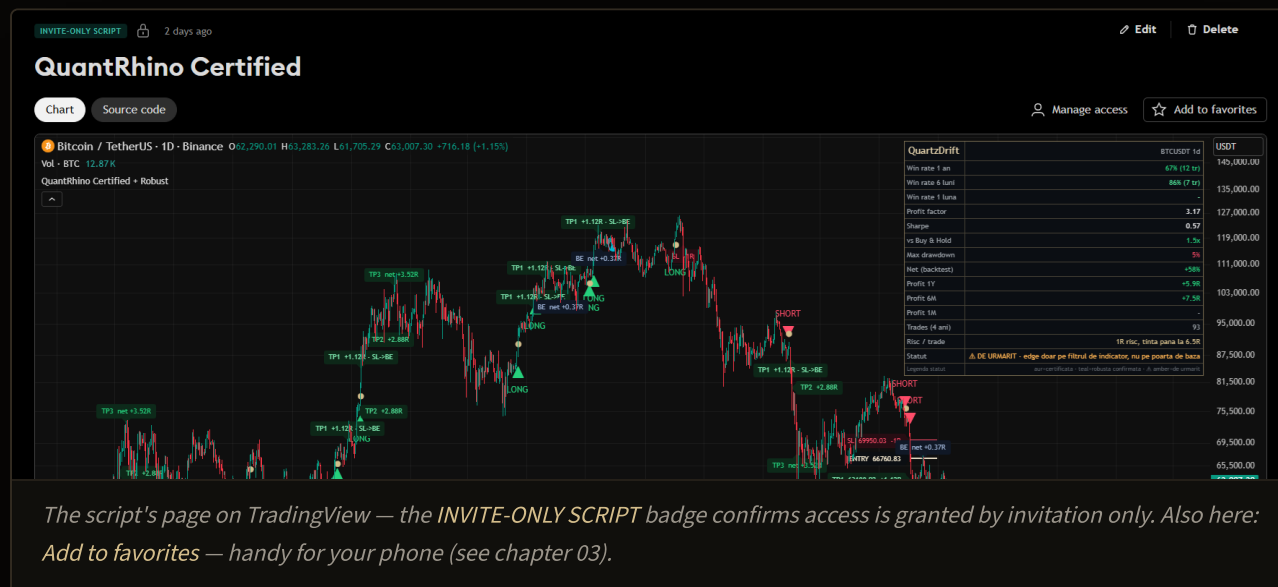
You gave it when applying for the beta (quantrhino.com/apply/). The invitation is granted to **exactly that username** — you'll see it under your profile picture on TradingView.

✓ Member access to the script

"QuantRhino Certified" is **invite-only** — it doesn't show up in public search. After your beta acceptance, the invitation is activated on your username.

HOW YOU KNOW ACCESS IS LIVE

You get a **notification in TradingView** (the bell, top right), and the script appears in the indicators window under the **"Invite-only scripts"** tab. Changed your username since applying? Reply to your member email with the new one and we'll re-invite you.





On laptop or *desktop*

1 Open a chart

At tradingview.com/chart, signed in. Any pair — for example **BINANCE:BTCUSDT**.

2 Click "Indicators" in the top bar (or press "/")

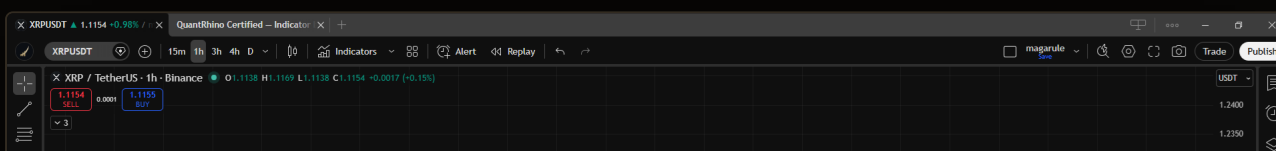
The button sits at the top, in the middle — see the screenshot below. The indicators window opens.

3 Go to the "Invite-only scripts" tab

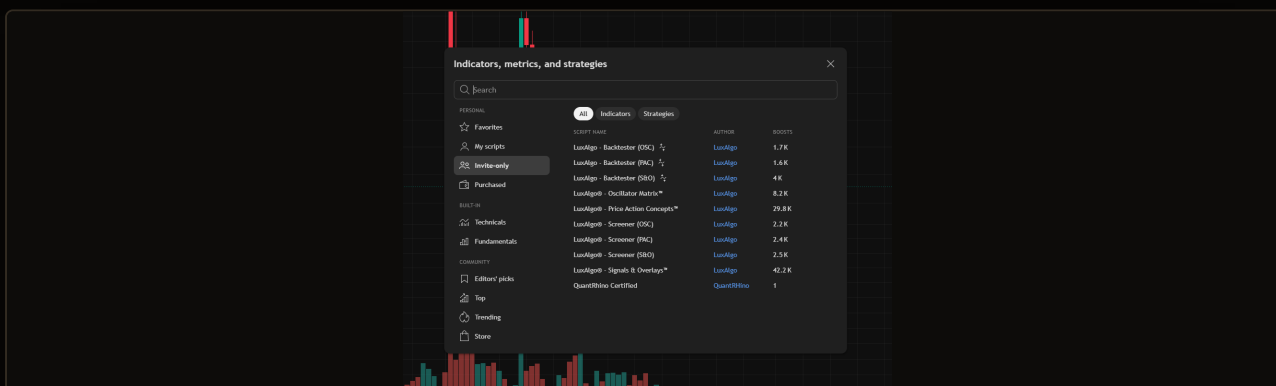
On the left of the window, below Favorites and My scripts. **That's where your indicator lives** — the tab only appears once you have at least one active invitation.

4 Click "QuantRhino Certified"

It's added to the chart instantly — the markings appear on the candles, the stats table in the corner.



Step 2: the Indicators button, in the chart's top bar. The "/" key does the same thing.



Steps 3–4, exactly where to click: on the left, under PERSONAL, the "Invite-only" tab — and in the list, "QuantRhino Certified". One click and it's on your chart.

DON'T SEE THE "INVITE-ONLY" TAB?

It means the invitation isn't active on your username yet. Check your TradingView notifications, or write to us (reply to your member email) and we'll fix it quickly.



On your phone (Android)

The same indicator, in the TradingView app — four steps, with the exact screens:



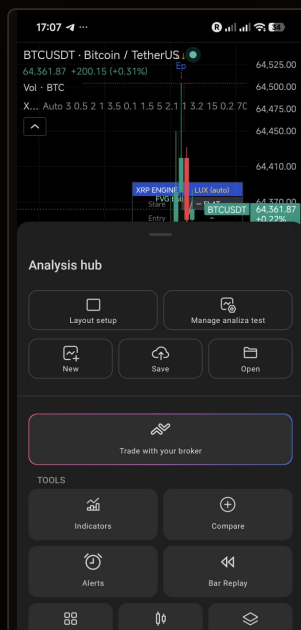
STEP 1

Open the app → pick your pair from the **Watchlist** (e.g. BTCUSDT), then the **Chart** tab at the bottom.



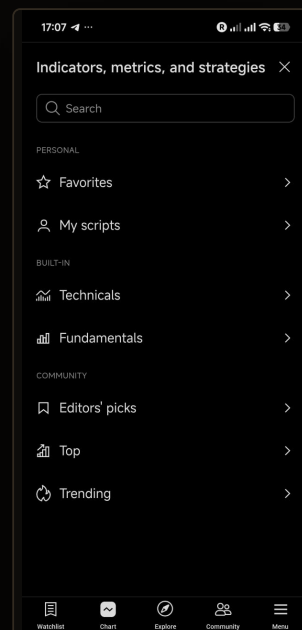
STEP 2

On the chart, set the strategy's timeframe (bottom, e.g. 4h) and tap the tools button in the bottom bar.



STEP 3

The **Analysis hub** opens → under **TOOLS** tap **Indicators**.



STEP 4

In "Indicators, metrics, and strategies": your indicator is under **Favorites** or **My scripts**.

WHERE TO FIND IT ON YOUR PHONE – THE TRICK THAT SAVES YOU SEARCHING

Invite-only scripts don't appear in public search on the phone either. The easiest way: **once, from your laptop or browser**, open the script's page and hit **"Add to favorites"** (see chapter 01). From that moment, on Android the indicator shows up instantly under **Favorites**, first in the list. Alternatively, find it under **My scripts** — the section for scripts you have access to.



Pick the strategy and *timeframe*

1 Set the chart to the strategy's pair and timeframe

For example **BINANCE:BTCUSDT on 4h**. The golden rule: a 4h strategy is used on 4h — on any other timeframe it won't trigger.

2 Open the indicator's settings

Double-click (on the phone: tap) the "QuantRhino Certified" name on the chart → pick the strategy from the list.

3 Or let AUTO mode choose

With **AUTO** ticked, the indicator detects the chart's coin and timeframe by itself and activates the best available strategy for that combination.



WORTH REMEMBERING: DASHBOARD = SNAPSHOT, SIGNALS = LIVE

Signals are computed live, on every candle. The stats table in the corner is a "snapshot" from when the version was published — the always-fresh numbers live in the terminal, at quantrhino.com/app.



Get the signals *wherever you are*

1 Open the alerts window

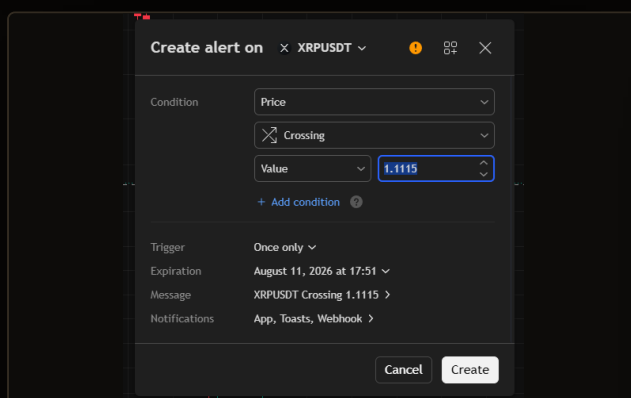
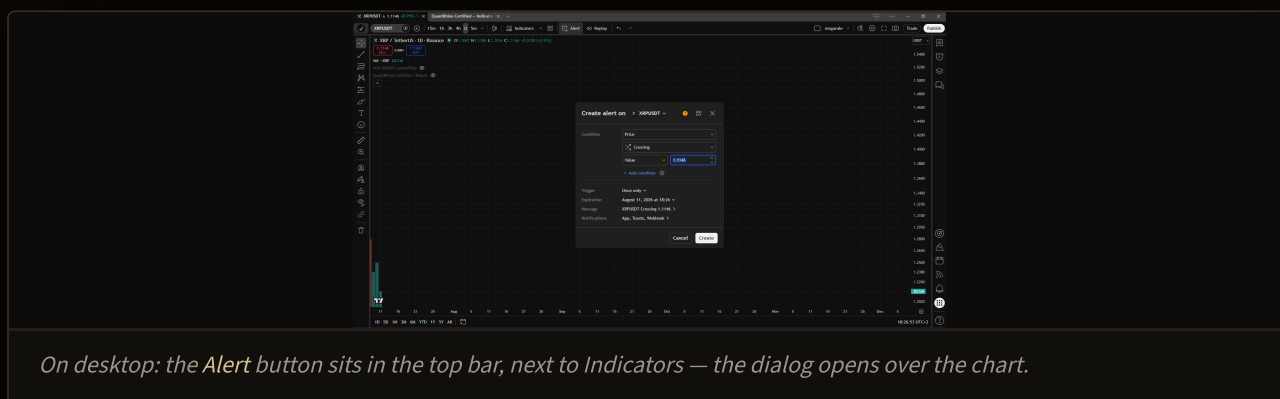
On laptop: right-click the chart → "Add alert" (or **Alt+A**). On Android: Analysis hub → **Alerts**.

2 Under "Condition" pick "QuantRhino Certified"

Select the indicator from the list and give the alert a clear name (e.g. "BTC 4h"). Trigger: leave it on the indicator's signals.

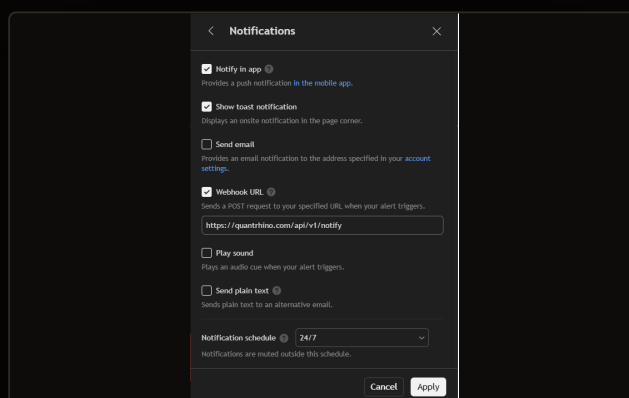
3 Under "Notifications" tick App + Webhook, then Create

Notify in app = push on your phone. **Webhook URL** = <https://quantrhino.com/api/v1/notify> — see below why it matters.



THE "CREATE ALERT" DIALOG

Under **Condition** pick "QuantRhino Certified"; at the bottom, under **Notifications**, you'll see "App, Toasts, Webhook". Then **Create**.

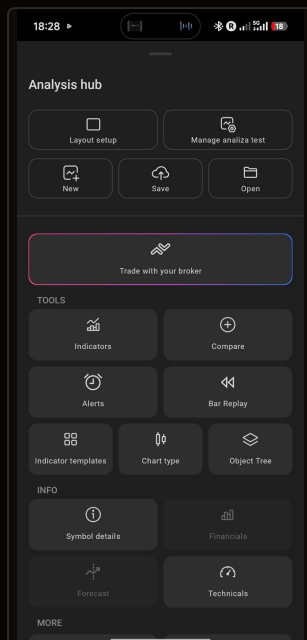


THE "NOTIFICATIONS" PANEL

Tick **Notify in app** (mobile push) and **Webhook URL** with quantrhino.com/api/v1/notify. Schedule: 24/7.

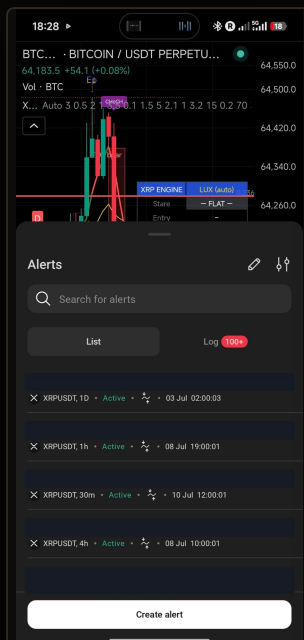


On your phone, *just as simple*



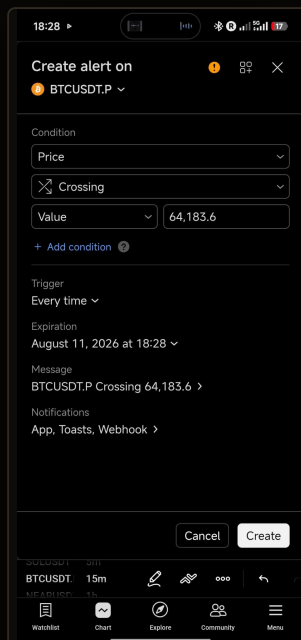
STEP 1

On the chart, open the **Analysis hub** → under TOOLS tap **Alerts**.



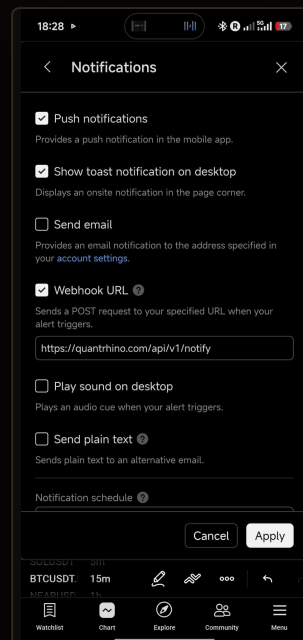
STEP 2

The **Alerts** panel shows your active alerts; at the bottom, **Create alert**.



STEP 3

Under **Condition** pick "QuantRhino Certified" and hit **Create** — same as on desktop.



STEP 4

Under **Notifications: Push notifications + Webhook URL** = `quantrhino.com/api/v1/notify`.

WHY WE NEED ALERTS (AND THE WEBHOOK)

For you: instant push on desktop and phone — you don't sit glued to the chart and you never miss a signal. **For honest record-keeping:** the webhook sends every triggered signal to the platform, and the terminal keeps the real signal record — exactly what fired and when. **For the noise filter:** from those same reports, the platform learns the market conditions in which a signal lost — and in the future, when the market looks the same as a known loss, the similar signal is filtered out before it costs you. Your alerts make the strategies cleaner, for everyone.

ALERTS FOLLOW THE CHART

An alert is tied to the **pair and timeframe** of the chart you created it on. Following several strategies? One alert per chart — once.



If something *doesn't work*

✓ I don't see the "Invite-only scripts" tab (laptop)

The invitation isn't active on your username yet — or you changed your username. Write to us from your member email and we'll redo it.

✓ I can't find it on my phone

Hit **"Add to favorites"** once on the script's page (from laptop/browser) — on Android it then shows under **Favorites**. Also check **My scripts**.

✓ No signals appear on the chart

Are you on the strategy's pair and timeframe? A 4h strategy won't trigger on 15m. The indicator doesn't "force" signals to look active — that's a feature, not a flaw.

✓ The stats table looks stale

That's normal: the dashboard is a snapshot from when the version was published. The daily-recalculated numbers are in the terminal — quantrhino.com/app.

✓ Alerts don't reach my phone

Install the TradingView app and allow notifications; also check the alert is active (not expired) in the alerts panel.
